5.	Page 4 of 12 on the RFP, Section 1 – Instructions & General Conditions, Subsection 22 mentions living wage requirements and no mention of prevailing wages. The sample contract on page 7 of 11 section 4.10 reads "the contractor shall comply with California prevailing wage law and requirements". What are the Corporation's requirements?	Contractor acknowledges, as applicable, it is familiar with and shall comply with and shall require all of its subcontractors to comply with current State of California Prevailing Wage law and requirements.
6.	What is the current pricing structure for all disposal recycling and organic services at the San Diego Convention Center?	Current pricing structure is comparable to the structure outlined in Exhibit B – Bid Form (Line Items).
7.	What is the current diversion rate for the Corporation?	Corporation's current diversion rate is approximately 60%.
8.	Who is the current hauler, and have there been any service issues? If so, what have they been?	Republic Services.
9.	Please clarify what specific information or components are required in the waste audit report (e.g., data, analysis, format).	The waste audit report shall contain the weight, contamination %, and material type.
10.	Should the cost of performing the waste audit be built into the overall service rates or listed as a separate line item in the bid pricing?	Built into the overall service rates.
